The following rules of the previous regulations apply

Scholarship increase for stays abroad

The amount of the scholarship is increased for any period of stay abroad, up to a maximum of 50 percent and for a total period not exceeding 18 months, if the student is authorised to carry out research activities abroad by the Teaching Body or, in case of stays up to 6 months, by the Degree Programme Coordinator.

Budget

Starting from the second year, each PhD student is ensured, within the financial resources existing in the budget of accredited subjects under current legislation, a budget for research activity in Italy and abroad, adequate with respect to the type of course and in any case for an amount not less than 10% of the amount of the scholarship. If the PhD student is not positively assessed for the purpose of renewing the scholarship, or s/he renounces to it, the unused amount remains available to the University, for the same purposes.

Compatible work activities

Admission to the PhD programme involves an exclusive and full-time commitment. Compatible work activities may still be carried out, subject to the authorisation of the Teaching Body. For PhD students with scholarships, work activities must be limited to those related to the acquisition of skills within the training area of the PhD; for PhD students without a scholarship, any incompatibility deriving from the work activity must in any case be assessed in practice without this causing a behaviour that damages constitutionally-protected rights, such as the right to study for capable and deserving students even if devoid of means.
